Geared Head Simulator



How to use:

- **TAKE ALL COMPONENTS OUT OF THE BOX**



- **PLACE THE **GEARED HEAD SIMULATOR (GHS)** CONTROLLER ON A YOUR DESK NEXT TO YOUR COMPUTER**



- Place the clamps on the edge of the table about 10-15cm apart from each other
- Place the two wheels on top of the clamps
Regular position is in an angle of 90° to each other



- Connect the plugs INTO the sockets on the backside of the GHS controller
Regular layout is
 - Tilt on the right hand
 - Pan on the left hand
- Connect the GHS controller and your computer with the supplied USB cable
- On the USB Stick choose your Operating System (OS) (Mac or Windows), copy to your computer (for better performance) and launch the GearHeadSimulator program

GHS Gearhead Simulator 1.4.app

- Inside the program choose the simulation you want to work with:



- Inside the simulation you can use these shortcuts:
 - Return: Settings
 - Space: Start recording
 - h: Help on/off
 - Esc: Back
 - w: Forward
 - a: Left
 - s: Backward
 - d: Right
 - r: Up
 - f: Down
 - t: Zoom in
 - g: Zoom out

You can change speed and wheel directions with the know and switches on the front of your controller.



With the DIP-Switch on the backside of the controller, you can change settings:

Switch 1: Change Control-Mode (ON = Mouse / OFF = Joystick)
